II. Jabez Asked the Lord for P
1) His P
1 Chron 2:55 "The families of the scribes lived at Jabez" John 14:12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do; because I go to the Father" Matt 28:18 "(Jesus Said)'All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth"
The warning is this: before God can enlarge our borders, God must first e us.
2 Cor 12:10 "Therefore, I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake; for when I am weak, then I am strong."
